EPISODE #101

SCENE 1: The team is gathered for their daily meeting. On the agenda: their upcoming four-day Indian wedding.

CHARACTERS/CAST: Jane, Joan, Michael, Tim

LOCATION: Main office.

CAMERAS: 2 -3 Cameras.

- Jane, Joan, Michael, Tim gathered for their daily meeting. Throughout the meeting, the dynamic between the team comes out. XX is making everyone laugh. XX has brought her injured dog Zeus – trying to focus on the meeting while making sure Zeus is okay.

- Story beat about everyone's role over the next four days.
- It is going to be a four-day marathon. How will the Priceless Affairs team handle one of their biggest events yet?
